

GangGang Gallery School Excursion Options

Self Guided Tour (Free)

Self Guided tours involve the teacher taking the children around the current exhibition and providing them with information on the artworks, posing questions and providing activities if desired. It is suggested teachers visit and view the current exhibition prior to bringing the students so they can plan their commentary, questions and activities. If an activity is planned please inform the Gallery staff before hand.

Gallery staff will meet the group at the main entrance and go through any risk management essentials including off limit areas, toilets, exits etc.

Bookings essential.

Guided Tour (Free)

Staff from the gallery can provided guided tours of the current exhibition for groups of up to 30. They will include information on the artworks and artist and ask questions of the students.

Gallery staff will meet the group at the main entrance and go through any risk management essentials including off limit areas, toilets, exits, etc prior to the tour.

Bookings essential.

Guided Tour and Activity (Costs apply, contact the Gallery for details)

Staff from the Gallery can provide an art activity related to the current exhibition following a guided tour. All materials will be provided.

Gallery staff will meet the group at the main entrance and go through any risk management essentials including off limit areas, toilets, exits etc.

Bookings essential.

Artist Talk (Costs apply, contact the Gallery for details)

The Gallery can arrange artist talks for some of the exhibitions. This option depends on the availability of artists. Artist talks can include discussions about the process they use to create their art, their inspirations, their journey as an artist and specific information on the artworks on exhibition.

Gallery staff will meet the group at the main entrance and go through any risk management essentials including off limit areas, toilets, exits etc.
